

**NOTE:** You can select the graphic on the right to increase its size; select it again to return it to its original size.


## Player Sections



This player has four main sections:

1. Outline
2. Additional Information
3. Player controls
4. Main presentation

## Course Outline Section




The Outline contains the course's table of contents. Content is grouped by the lesson or topic and by the subject area. Each group can be expanded or collapsed by selecting the arrows to the left of the text.

Each page listed in the Outline contains a link that, when selected, will navigate directly to its associated page. Once you click on the link, you will have access to content, interactions, and practice items found in the main presentation area.

Some interactions and animations may contain additional internal navigation. For example:

- Interactions contain navigation buttons in the upper right-hand corner
- Practice items contain navigation buttons in the lower right-hand corner

## Player Controls Section




The Player Controls section displays the page or slide number and provides buttons to control the volume, navigate from page to page, and change how the course is viewed.

- Volume - Allows you to adjust the loudness of any audio.
- Player Controls - Allow you to play (>) or pause (||) any action that is happening on the screen, navigate to the previous screen (<|), or advance to the next screen (|>).
- Full Screen - Allows you to select one of three different views:
  1. With or without the outline
  2. Full screen
  3. Normal

**NOTE:** Interactions and practice items have additional internal navigation controls. Follow the specific directions given for these items.

## Additional Information Section




The Additional Information section provides access to:

- Acronyms - A list of acronyms used in the course
- Course Interface - This interaction containing information on how to navigate the course


## Main Presentation Section - General



The main presentation area presents information in three ways:


1. Text

## Main Presentation Section - Text



Text-based information presented in the main viewing area may also contain hyperlinks to additional information. Select the text hyperlink to access a pop-up window. Select Close in the pop-up window to return to the main page.

## Main Presentation Section - Interactions and Animations




Interactions and animations presented in the main presentation section provide additional information that you must access. The information may be accessed in a linear manner by selecting the previous (<|) and next (|>) buttons in the upper right-hand corner. However, you may also access the information in a non-linear manner by selecting one of the following:

- The animated buttons (+)
- A tab (e.g., the rectangles at the top of this interaction)
- A shape in the animation (e.g., segment of the circle)

To close pop-up windows, click on the "X" in the upper right-hand corner or simply select another button in the main viewing area.

The introduction to each interaction and animation will contain additional guidance.

## Main Presentation Section - Practice Items and Questions




Practice items and questions presented in the main presentation section are designed to reinforce concepts learned. Information displayed in this section may contain one or more pages or questions, as indicated by the question count. You need to use the question's internal navigation to:

- Move from page to page (internal Next button)
- Move from question to question (internal SUBMIT button)



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

## What if my course stops responding?




If your screen remains idle for 60 minutes, Intelink will time out and your course will stop responding until you select the **Refresh** button in the browser. Intelink will require you to sign back onto the site and your course will resume where you left off.

## Where did my bookmarks go?



Bookmarking is saved on the computer on which you start the course. If you work on a different computer/workstation, the course bookmarking will be reset and you will have to restart the course. However, you may use the links in the Outline to pick up where you left off.

## Can I use any keyboard shortcuts?



There are several different keyboard shortcuts that you can use in the player.

- **Arrow Left, Arrow Up, or Page Up:** Play Previous Slide
- **Arrow Right, Arrow Down, or Page Down:** Play Next Slide
- **Home key:** Play First Slide
- **End key:** Play Last Slide
- **Spacebar:** Play/Pause
- **/ T / N / S:** Select Tabs - Outline, Thumbnails, Notes, Search
- **N:** Toggle Slide Notes
- **V:** Toggle Display View Modes
- **M:** Toggle Audio Mute
